

TOXIC CUP – TEAM REGISTRATION GUIDE

Team Registration Requirements & Process

This section outlines all information, documents, and payments required for teams entering the Toxic Cup.

1. Registration Overview

All teams must complete:

- tournament registration
- roster submission
- payment
- waiver acceptance

before being officially accepted into the tournament.

Registration is only confirmed once:

- all forms are completed
 - payment is received
 - required documents are approved
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2. Team Information Required

A. Team Name

Teams must provide:

- official club/team name
- age division entered

Example

- Sheffield Steel U10
 - Essex Raiders U12
 - Team Toxic UK U8
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B. Head Coach Details

The Head Coach will act as the primary team contact.

Required information:

- full name

- mobile number
- email address

The Head Coach is responsible for:

- player eligibility
 - team conduct
 - communication with tournament staff
 - roster accuracy
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C. Emergency Contact Information

Each team must provide:

- emergency contact name
- emergency contact number

This should be:

- a responsible adult
 - reachable throughout the event
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3. Insurance Confirmation

All participating teams must confirm they hold valid insurance covering:

- players
- coaches
- team staff

Teams may be required to provide:

- insurance provider
- policy number
- governing body affiliation

The Tournament Organizer reserves the right to refuse participation without valid insurance confirmation.

4. Player & Goalie Roster Submission

Roster Deadline

All rosters must be submitted before the published roster deadline.

Late roster changes require approval from the Tournament Director.

5. Player Roster Requirements

Maximum Roster

- 12 skaters
 - 2 goalies
 - Maximum total roster: 14 players
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Player Information Required

For each player:

- full name
 - jersey number
 - date of birth
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6. Goalie Registration

Teams must identify:

- registered goalie(s)

Goalies must:

- meet age eligibility
- wear full approved protective equipment

Emergency goalie requests are subject to Tournament Director approval.

7. Player Eligibility Verification

Tournament staff may request proof of age at any time.

Accepted documents:

- passport
- birth certificate
- official registration card

Teams using ineligible players may face:

- forfeits
- disqualification

- suspension from future events
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8. Waiver & Consent Forms

All teams must complete tournament waivers before participation.

Waivers Include

- injury acknowledgment
- participation consent
- medical treatment consent
- photography/media consent
- conduct agreement

No waiver = no participation.

9. Payment Process

Entry Fee

Tournament entry fee:

£650 per team

Teams are not officially confirmed until payment is received.

10. Invoice Process

Once registration is accepted:

- teams will receive an official invoice
- payment instructions will be included

Invoices will include:

- team name
 - division entered
 - amount due
 - payment deadline
 - bank/payment details
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11. Payment Methods

Accepted payment methods may include:

- bank transfer

Cash payments are not accepted unless approved in advance.

12. Refund Policy

Team Withdrawal Policy

- No refund unless replacement team is found
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14. Tournament Cancellation

If the event is cancelled by the organizer due to:

- venue closure
- severe weather
- safety concerns
- unforeseen circumstances

teams will receive either:

- full refund
OR
- event credit

depending on recoverable venue/event costs.

15. Registration Confirmation

Once approved, teams will receive:

- tournament confirmation
 - event schedule
 - venue information
 - rules pack
 - roster confirmation
 - event-day instructions
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
